School Rules

- Show respect for staff and other students
- Support other children. Be helpful and stop any bullying by telling any member of staff or an adult at home
- Have good manners
- Behave well and do as staff tells you.
- When you move around the school, think of others. It is best to walk quietly and carefully.
- Be on time for school
- Be prepared for class
- Do your homework and get your notebook signed
- Do not damage any property
- Use appropriate language at all times

Going to school

- Listen to what is being said and take part when you are asked
- Treat other children with respect when they speak
- After assembly, go quietly to your classroom with your teacher and special needs assistants.
