

Offences leading to Detention/Suspension/Expulsion

- Physical abuse of children or staff
- Leaving the school premises or classroom without permission
- Bringing substances to school or coming to school having abused substances
- Persistent abusive/threatening language directed towards children or staff
- Persistent refusal to take instruction
- Stealing or damaging property
- Bringing a dangerous item to school
- Constant bullying
- Endangering themselves or others

The above offences may result in the following:

- Staying back after school where possible
- Exclusion from major trips
- Letter to parents or guardians
- Exclusion for a number of days where there is a persistent serious offence. Warnings may be given. Exclusion will be by arrangement with parents.
- Internal exclusion from class for a number of days.
- Serious assault and persistent endangerment of self/others may result in withdrawal of school placement.
